

# Brush & Limb Pick Up (Normally Last Monday of Every Month)

DAY: Monday December 30, 2019

**TIME: 7:00 AM** 

**WHERE: Street Curb Of Residency** 

LIMBS: Should be reasonably fresh and solid (no stacks of rotten wood). Should be no larger than 6" in diameter and no longer than 12 feet. Should be stacked in one pile, turned parallel to the edge of the street. (\*\*Do not put next to light poles) **SMALL BRUSH**: Should be bundled and tied with string or twine. Hedge trimmings will be accepted if bundled. No grass clippings accepted.

**DAY: Monday, December 30, 2019 & January 6, 2020 TIME: 7:00 AM** 

WHERE: Street Curb Of Residency. Not street. (Reminder remove all decorations, stands, nails and plastic bags.)

Addendum (Reference E. Yard Equipment and Devices, paragraph 8) Effective: October 23, 2019 Supersedes: N/A

8. Resin/polycarbonate storage unit for concealment of trash and recycle containers

Homeowner must send to the ARC an application showing size, color, and placement of the unit for approval before purchasing. The unit must meet the following guidelines:

- It must adjoin or abut the house.
- It must be no larger than 5 feet wide, 4 feet tall, and 3 feet deep.
- It must be white or match the color of the house.
- It must be water- and weather-resistant. It can have a floor and/or top.
- It must be installed in the back of the home or on the side if installation in the back is not possible. It cannot stand away from the house or along a fence.
- It must be of high-quality manufacture and must be maintained in good condition.
