Brush & Limb Pick Up (Normally Last Monday of Every Month) DAY: Monday September 28, 2020

TIME: 7:00 AM

WHERE: Street Curb Of Residency

NOTE: LIMBS: Should be reasonably fresh and solid (no stacks of rotten wood). Should be no larger than 6" in diameter and no longer than 12 feet. Should be stacked in one pile, turned parallel to the edge of the street. (**Do not put next to light poles) SMALL BRUSH: Should be bundled and tied with string or twine. Hedge trimmings will be accepted if bundled. No grass clippings accepted.

When selecting your pergola for your Kinderton home, select a non wood materia and follow the below specifications from the ARC guidelines, standards and specifications. Homeowner must send to the ARC an application showing construction

materials, size, color, and placement of the Pergola for approval before

- Pergola must be a permanent structure. It must be attached to the house or bolted to the patio -CANNOT BE PORTABLE
- Pergola must have flat, crossbeam, open roof. Pergola may have a detachable, muted, sunscreen shade across top that can be
- removed. Pergola must be White, Black, Gray, or

purchasing.

- Brown vinyl or metal structure. The size can be no larger than 12 feet
- Pergola must be of high-quality manufacture and must be maintained in good condition.


RESIDENT YARD POLITICAL SIGNS

Ways to Stay Safe

Here is a checklist suggested by Community Officer, Zach Williams:


